weeks and at least fifteen days previous
thereto due public notice was given
by the ministers of such Society in the
manner directed by the Statute in such
case made and provided, on which day
and at the place aforesaid and at such
meeting the undersigned two of the mem-
bers of said Society nominated for that
purpose by a majority of the male persons
of full age belonging to said Society
there assembled presided at such election
to receive the votes of the electors and to
be the judges of their qualifications and
of the persons elected and thereupon
by a plurality of voices of the persons
so assembled and qualified the
following named persons were duly
elected to serve as trustees for such
Society according to law, that is to say:

Harnden A. Olmsted, John Shwing, Alva Paul, Henry Steuber and Gideon D. Crofoot.

And we the inspectors aforesaid so presiding at such meeting hereby further certify and return the names of the trustees so thereupon elected, and that the name or title by which the said trustees and their successors in office as such shall forever hereafter be called and known is and shall be "The Trustees of the First Universalist Society of LeRoy" and which is herein and hereby particularly mentioned and described in pursuance of the statute in such case made and provided.

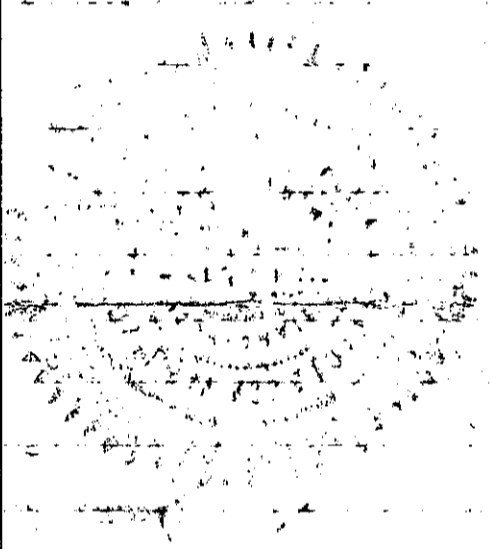
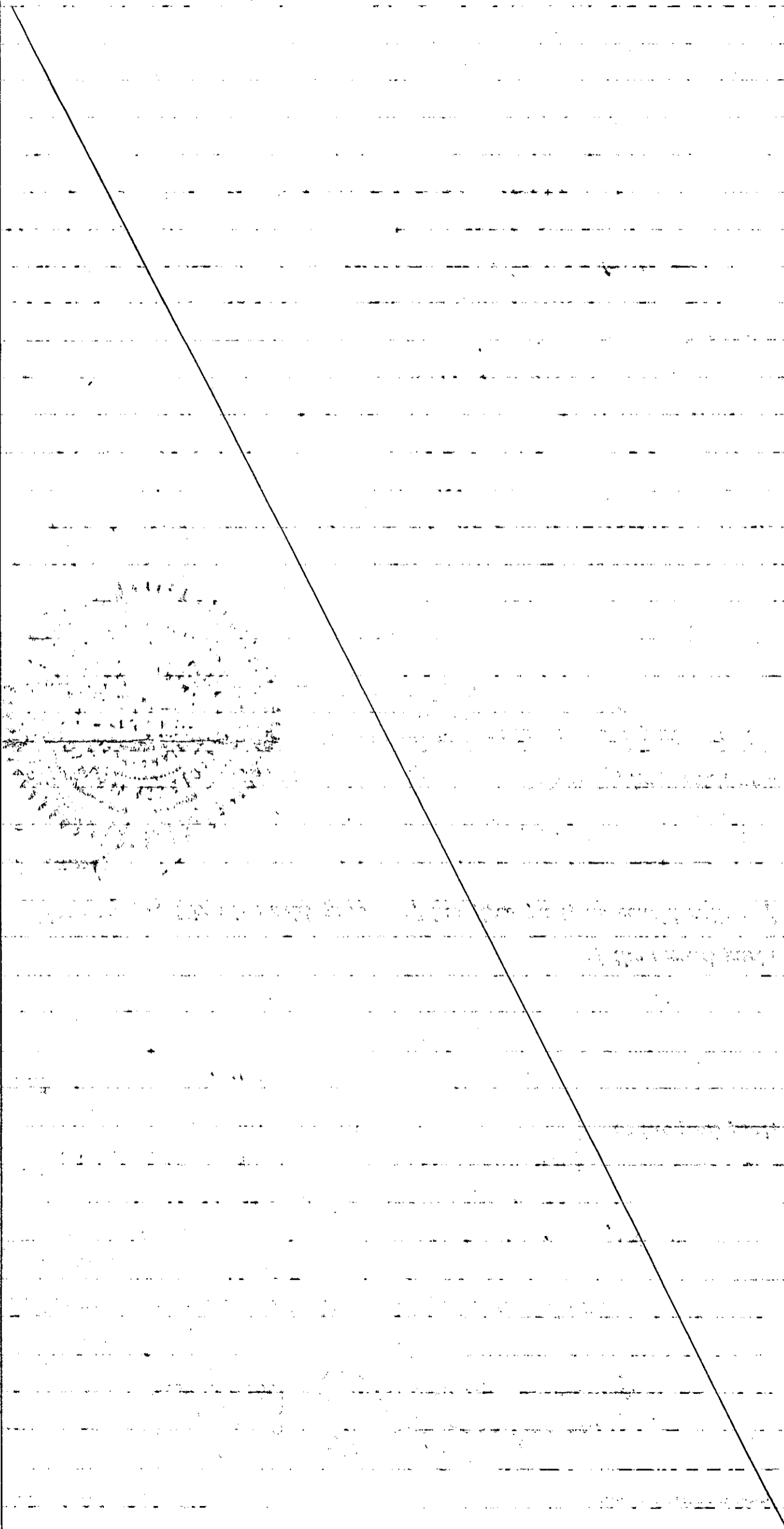

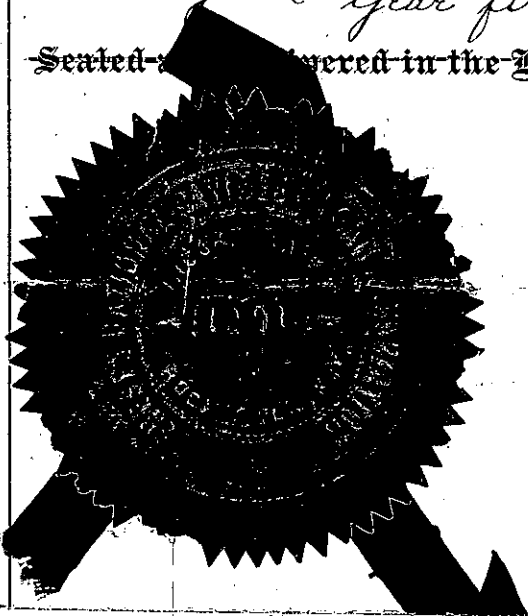
