

**Albion, Orleans Co. NY**

Certificate of Incorporation of  
The Pullman Memorial Universalist Church of Albion, New York  
To Whom it May Concern

We hereby certify that pursuant to the Laws of the State of New York, the persons belonging to the congregation or religious society, known as the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church of Albion, New York assembled August 2, 1891, at the place where they statedly attend for divine worship viz: the Court House in the village of Albion, Orleans Co. New York, and the minister of said congregation publicly notified the congregation that at the same place, and on the 18th day of August at 2:30 P.M. 1891, an election would be made by said congregation by a plurality of voices of such number of discreet persons, members thereof, not less than three nor more than nine trustees as such congregation might determine to take charge of the estate and property belonging thereto and to transact all affairs relative to the temporalities thereof, and that such notification was again given August 9, 1891 to said congregation; on the 9th and 16th days of August 1891 respectively, and that on the 18th day of August 1891, at the time and place so designated and of which such notice was so given, the said congregation assembled pursuant to said notice when J. D. Billings and Chas. A. Danolds (there being no Elders of said church) were nominated by a majority of the members to preside at said election, and we hereby certify that thereupon by a majority of the votes cast by the members of said congregation so assembled for that purpose, the following named persons were elected to serve as trustees for the above named Church or society, viz: Charles A. Danolds, John Lattin, Mrs. Joseph Hart, 3 years; Sheldon Warner, William A. Tanner, Mrs. S. S. Spencer, 2 years; J. D. Billings, Adelbert Chapman, Mrs. F. E. Kittridge, 1 year.
