Whereas at a meeting of citizens having assembled at Boonville in the County of Oneida on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1830 at the Union Church in said town agreeable to legal & previous notice for the purpose of forming themselves into a religious Society in conformity with the third section of the act entitled an act to provide for the incorporation of Religious Societies passed April 5<sup>th</sup> 1813[,] And whereas Aaron Willard and Ela Merriam male persons of full age having been called to preside at & receive the votes of the electors do certify that Lorin Miller, Cyrus Wetmore, James Simonds, John Fish & Josiah Woodworth were duly elected to serve as trustees of a religious Society to be known by the name or title of The First Universalist Society in Boonville[.] Given under our hands & seals the day & year first above written
