

**Carlisle, Schoharie Co. NY
(Argusville)**

To all to whom these presents shall come, greetings:

Wherein in accordance with the provisions of a law passed on the fifth day of April, 1813, and the laws amendatory thereto, relating to the incorporation of religious societies, the following persons viz. David H. Relyea, Orren M. Griffith, John Anthony, Myron Hillsinger, Monroe Eldredge, L. W. Baxter, Clarissa Hillsinger, [Jemie?] Dornburgh, Addison Dornburgh, Clara Minor, [and] Sarah Weiss met at the Universalist Church at Argusville, Schoharie county, N.Y. on the 18th day of June 1888, agreeably to public notice given in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided for the purpose of incorporating the Universalist Church or Society at Argusville. And the said above named persons were heretofore accustomed to meet at said Universalist Church to attend services under the auspices of the Universalist Church or denomination. The meeting was duly called to order and Messrs. David H. Relyea and Orren M. Griffith were duly and regularly elected to preside at such meeting. Thereupon the meeting proceeded to the election of three trustees with the following result: Messrs. John Anthony, Myron Hillsinger and Monroe Eldredge were each duly and unanimously elected trustees. Thereupon the meeting unanimously agreed upon the following as the corporate name of the society, to wit: "The Universalist Church of Argusville." And we the returning officers do certify that Messrs. John Anthony, Myron Hillsinger and Monroe Eldredge were duly and legally elected trustees of the Universalist Church of Argusville, and that the corporate name of the Universalist society is "The Universalist Church of Argusville," agreeably to the statute in such case made and provided.
