Cortlandville, Cortland Co. NY (Cortlandville)

Be it remembered that the male members of the Universalist Society in Homer & Cortlandville convened at there [sic] meeting house in Cortlandville on the 7th day of May in the year of our Lord 1839 for the purpose of organizing the saide [sic] society[,] legal notice having been given for that purpose[.] [O]n examining the records it appeared that the said Society was legally incorporated in November 1813 by the name of the first Charitable Universalist Religious Society in the town of Homer[.] [I]t further appears that the certificate of incorporation by a new name made in January 1829 was not legally acknowledged thereof proceeded to reincorporate and reorganize said society[.] Reverend A. C. Barray was chosen moderator and proceeded to business[.] First resolved that we reincorporate the First Charitable Universalist Religious Society of the town of Homer which was incorporated November 1813 by the name of the First Universalist society of the Appointed Mead Merrill and Jacob Badgley returning town of Cortlandville. officers. Voted that we have six trustees. Voted that Mead Merrill[,] Jacob Badgley[,] Erastus Berry[,] Benjamin Roberts[,] Orin Persons and Talmon Barnham be said Trustees[:]

First Class Orin Persons Benjamin Roberts 2d Class Talmon Barnham Mead Merrill 3d Class Jacob Badgley Erastus Berry
