We the undersigned two of the members of the congregation hereafter mentioned, do hereby certify that on the 3rd day of February A.D. 1867 in pursuance of notice duly given to the said congregation in the time of service on two Sundays previous to such meeting, the male persons of full age belonging to a congregation in which Divine worship is celebrated according to the rites of the congregation & not already incorporated met at the place of public worship heretofore occupied by the said congregation in the Town of Cuba in said county for the purpose of incorporating themselves and did then and there elect by plurality of votes John Brooks, C. A. Reynolds & Freeman L. Sibley Trustees and the said persons did then and there also determine by the like plurality of votes that the said Trustees and their successors should forever hereafter be called and known by the name of the Trustees of the first Universalist Society of the Village of Cuba.
