We the undersigned, two of the members of the Religious Society hereinafter mentioned do hereby certify that in pursuance of due notice for that purpose given and read under and in accordance with the [directions?] of the Act of the Legislature for that purpose made and [?] did the male persons of full age belonging to a Religious Society called "The First Universalist Society in Mount Vernon" not already incorporated met on the twelfth day of February in the year eighteen hundred and fifty five at Tourneaux? [?] at the corner of the Fifth Avenue and Fourth Street in the village of Mount Vernon in the County of West Chester aforesaid, (that being the place where they statedly attend for Divine Worship) for the purpose of incorporating themselves and electing trustees of and for the said Society: That at the time and place aforesaid there being no elders or churchwardens belonging to the said Society, the undersigned[,] two of the members of said Society[,] were nominated by a majority of the members present to preside at such election and thereupon such election was held and by a plurality of voices the following persons were elected to serve as Trustees for the said Society—namely Horace McGowen[,] Cornelius A. Cooper, and William Bertino: and we further certify that the name or title by which the said Trustees and their successors shall for ever hereafter be called and known shall be "The First Universalist Society of Mount Vernon."

In Testimony Whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this twelfth day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five[.]
