Be it remembered that at a meeting of the male members of the Universalist Society held at the Union Meeting House in the town of Fairfield on the tenth day of February 1835 pursuant to public notice and according to the statute incorporating and regulating religious societies in such case made and provided David Ford and George W. Britton were duly nominated and elected to preside at said meeting and to certify and return the proceedings thereof to the clerk of said county[;] That at said meeting it was unanimously resolved and agreed that said society should forever hereafter be known and distinguished by the name and title of the first Universalist Society of Middleville[;] That the following persons were then and there duly elected Trustees of said Society to wit John Farmer E^{sq}[,] Asaph Scott, David Ford, Wanton Weeden[,] Benjamin L. Kuler [&] Ira Farmer[,] and that said trustees and their successors shall for ever after be known and called by the name and title of the trustees of the First Universalist Society of Middleville—In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written
