Homer, Cortland Co. NY (Cortland*)

At a meeting of a number of male inhabitants of the town of Homer convened at the house of David Merrick in Cortland village on Monday the 19th day of January 1829 for the purpose of forming themselves into a Religious Society according to law after due notice given forth [?] it is now Resolved that we the subscribers should preside at said meeting and make returns of such persons as shall be elected Trustees and it was further resolved that the Society be known by the name of the first Unaversalist [sic] Society of the town of Homer[,] whereupon they proceeded to choose [?] Trustees by plurality of votes and ascertaining that fact it appeared that David Peck and Jacob Badgley were duly elected Trustees of said Society. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written
