We the subscribers do hereby certify under our hands and seals That on the Twenty Third day of March in the Year of Our Lord one Thousand, Eight hundred and seventeen at the place where the Society held their stated meetings (notice having been given at the said place at least fifteen days before the election and for two successive Sabbaths) we were chosen by a majority of the members present to preside at the Election of Trustees for the said Society in the manner directed by an act of the Legislature of the State of New York entitled and act to provide for the incorporation of Religious Society [sic] passed 5th of April 1813 and at the said election Hezekiah Dayton, Joseph Watson, William Bates, William R. Macy, Peter Taylor, Miron Ackley and Gayer Gardner were elected Trustees of a Religious Society to be denominated the first Universal Society and Church in the City of Hudson.
