This may certify that at a meeting of persons professing themselves to be believers in the doctrine of Universal Salvation from sin by Grace and holden in the Town of Massena on the twenty-first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five for the purpose of organizing themselves into a Religious Society agreeably to the Statute of this State for such purposes made and provided. Said meeting proceeded to the business of organizing by calling Rev. E. A. Garfield to the chair and Alfred Colburn clerk. The meeting then were [sic] called by the chairman to the election of officers for said Society by acclamation[.] Martin S. Crowley was chosen clerk, Alfred Colburn Treasurer, and Cornelius Barns, Enos Beach, and Joseph Tucker, Trustees[.] Also resolved that the Society thus organized shall be distinguished and known by the name of the "First Universalist Society of Massena." Done in the presence of the meeting this $21^{\rm st}$ day of September 1835.
