## Mina, Chautauqua Co. NY

At a meeting of the Universalists assembled at the school house in district number four, in the town of Mina on the 9 day of December 1834 in pursuance of publick notice given, Elias E. D. Wood & Simeon Park was [sic] elected to preside as the [?] of election[,] Lorin Park as Clerk pro tem.

Resolved that this society be called the first Universalist Society of Mina[.]

Res<sup>d</sup> that there shall be three trustees & that John Bartlett[,] Lorin Park & John S. Boardwell were elected trustees, who are classed as follows viz. John Bartlett three years[,] John S. Boardwell two years[,] Lorin Parker one year.
