This may certify that on the sixteenth day of February 1839 a number of the inhabitants of the town of Nelson[,] County of Madison who had been supporters and constant attendance [sic] of the Universalist meetings in that place assembled agreeable to notice legally given for that purpose at the usual place of worship in order to take measures to incorporate themselves into a Society according to the statute made and provided in such case and after electing Benjamin Turner and Wm. M. DeLong presiding officers in said meeting made choice of Benjamin Turner[,] Geo. D. Richardson [and] Ruel Richardson as Trustees to be known and designated [and] distinguished by the name of the First Universalist Society in Nelson. In testimony the undersigned presiding officers have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
