We John Herttell and Jacob Clinch two of the members of the Religious Society of United Christian Friends in the City of New York do certify that at a meeting of the said Society duly convened in the church of the said society, situated in the Sixth Ward of the said City of New York on the day of the date hereof for the purpose of choosing Trustees for the said Society pursuant to the Statute in such case made and provided, the following persons were nominated and by a plurality of votes elected and chosen Trustees for the said Society, to wit William Palmer, Edward Mitchell, Richard Wilmshurst, Seth Wayland, Abraham Degrauw and the said Jacob Clinch the said Trustees hereafter to be called, distinguished and known by the stile [sic] name or title of "The Trustees for the Society of United Christian Friends in the City of New York." In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one.
