At a meeting of the inhabitance [sic] freeholders of the towns of Perinton, Mendon, Pittsford and Victor convened at the house occupied by W^m Cogswell at Bushnells Basin on the fifteenth day of February 1826 agreeably to notice given according to the statute made and provided for the purpose of forming themselves into a religious society, John Ladd was chosen chairman & Lyman Wilmarth secretary— On motion resolved that this society be hereafter known and distinguished by the name of the "Central Universalian Society of Perinton[,] Mendon[,] Pittsford and Victor"—Proceeded to the choice of trustees whereupon Jeremiah Richardson, Levi Treadwell, Joseph Armstrong, Joseph Olney & Lyman Wilmarth were chosen Trustees of said society— In witness whereof the chairman & secretary have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written—
