Eaton[,] George Hine[,] Henry Matthews[,] Samuel R. Thompson and Larry Wilcox were duly nominated and elected as said Trustees—Resolved unanimously that the trustees elected at this meeting and their successors shall forever hereafter be called and known by the name of the Fairport Universalist Society—
