To whomsoever it may concern this may certify that at a meeting held at the School House in the Sixth district in the town of Perry on the nineteenth day of Sept. 1821 instant pursuant to public notice previously and duly given for the purpose of organizing a society agreeable to the 3^d Section of an act entitled an Act to provide for the incorporation of Religious Societies passed the 27th March 1801 Thos. E. Parmelee and Amos Otis two of the members of said Society were now elected by a majority of the members present to preside at said meeting and election and to return the naims [sic] of the persons who by plurality of voices should be elected to serve as trustees for the said congregation[.] We the said Thos . E. Parmelee and Amos Otis aforesaid do certify that at said meeting Josiah Williams[,] Dan Dickerson and Munson Eddy were by a plurality of voices elected to serves as trustees for said society[.] We do also certify that the naim [sic] or title by which said Trustees and their successors are hereafter to be known [is] the trustees of the first United Uneverselist [sic] Society in Perry and the county of Genesee thereof and said title was there and [then] agreed on by said meeting
