B. Houghton, Y. R. Chapman, M. M. Ransom, S. W. Gray, C. Benedict, A. Fuller, A. Zoller, O. Angel and S. O. Gay as Trustees of said Religious Society and the said persons did then and there also determine by the like plurality of voices that the said Trustees and their successors should forever after be called and known by the name or title of the First Universalist Society of Rockton, Herkimer Co., N.Y.
