Armstrong, Samuel B. Stevens, B. W. Williams[,] Harman Emerson and B. A. Gage as Trustees of the said Church and the said persons did then and there also determine by the like plurality of voices that the said Trustees and their successors should forever hereafter be called and known by the name or title of The Trustees of the First Universalist Church of Rome.
