Be it remembered that at a meeting of the male members of the first Society of Universalists held at their usual place of worship in the Village of Liverpool and town of Salina on the twenty first day of April 1833 pursuant to public notice and according to the statute incorporating & regulating religious societies in such case made and provided, Joseph Jaqueth and Ebenezer L. Adams were duly nominated and elected to preside at said meeting and to certify and return the proceedings thereof to the Clerk of said County— That at said meeting it was unanimously resolved & agreed that the said Society should forever hereafter be known and distinguished by the name and title of "The First Society of Universalists in the Village of Liverpool." That the following persons were then & there duly elected Trustees of said Society to wit: Harvey Kimball[,] Caleb Hubbard and John Paddock[,] and that said Trustees and their successors shall forever hereafter be known and called by the name and title of "The Trustees of the First Society of Universalists in the Village of Liverpool." In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written[.]
