We the undersigned do hereby certify that at a meeting held at the school house at Beardsley's Corners in the town of Scipio agreeably to a notice given according to law on the 22^d day May 1836 [sic] for the organizing a society to be called the first Universalist Society in the town of Scipio. Worden Babcock and Harvey Boughton were duly chosen to preside at said meeting. This meeting preceded the election of officers whereupon Worden Babcock[,] Asa Way and Jacob Morgan were duly elected trustees of said society.
