Peck[,] Ellw[.] Smith and Marvin Lord were chosen Trustees of said society and are to be known by the name of United Society of Universalists of the Town of LeRoy and Stafford they being [?] men of our society and that the said trustees have steady worshipped with said society and have personally been conscientious belonging thereto. In witness whereof we have set our hands and seals this fourth day of Oct 1823 at Stafford[,] Genesee County[,] New York.
