B. Champion [and] Henry Hawn for two years, M. C. Smith [and] O. H. Springer for one year as trustees of said religious society corporation & the said persons did then and there also determine by the like plurality of voices that the trustees and successors shall forever hereafter be called and known by the name and title of the First Universalist Parish of the Town of Stark.
