## Sullivan, Madison Co. NY

Be it remembered that on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty six that at a meeting of the male persons of full age convened at the meeting house in Sullivan village in the Town of Sullivan & county of Madison being one of the places where the said inhabitants statedly attend Divine Worship and in pursuance of the act entitled an act to provide for the incorporation of Religious societys [sic] passed April the 5<sup>th</sup> 1813. And by a regular vote formed themselves into a religious society by the name of the first Universalist Society of the Town of Sullivan. On which day (due notice having been given previously according to the directions of the said act) the said meeting by a plurality of voices elected six Trustees of the first Universalist Society of the Town of Sullivan. The said Trustees being elected by classes in pursuance of the said act as follows—for the first class Jacob Patrick & Henry Rice[,] for the second class Elisha Swift & Levi Spaulden, for the third class Alpheus Britt & Benjamin C. Burton, to hold their respective offices according to the time prescribed in & by the said act.
