At a meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Union in the County of Broome, convened at the School house in the first District in said town of Union, on the twenty seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, for the purpose of forming themselves in a Religious Society agreeable to "an act to incorporate Religious Societies" whereas Benjamin Chambers and Samuel Allen was [sic] chosen to preside at said meeting, whereupon it was unanimously resolved that Joseph Chambers, Samuel Crocker and Jesse Richards be Trustees of the Society, and it was further Resolved that the name and Stile [sic] of this Society by which they shall be known shall be the First Unaversalist [sic] Society in Union—We the undersigned do certify the above to be in all respects just and true the day and year above written—In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals[.]
