Abel Simonds was chosen Clerk & John S. Flagler, Moderator. Resolved that this Society be called the first Universalist Society in the towns of Venice and Scipio. Resolved, that Worden Babcock, Abel Simonds, William Culver, Jacob Morgan, Henry Snyder and Titus Fish be the Trustees of said Society.

Resolved that the annual meeting for the choice of Trustees be held the first Thursday in March. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 10th day of March in the year of our Lord 1825.
