To all whom these presents may come, greetings; this may certify that at a meeting of the male members of the Universalist Society of the Town of Victor in the County of Ontario held at the meeting house occupied by the said society on the first day of January in the year 1834 according to notice duly given according to the statute in such cases made and provided, the reverend Stephen Miles was called to the chair and Axel Berray was appointed clerk of said meeting. Whereupon it was voted by said meeting, that the said society should be organized and known hereafter always by the name and title of the first Universalist Society of Victor and the following persons were duly elected by said meeting to be known by the name and title of Trustees of the first Universalist Society of Victor to wit: Ezra Wilmarth, Samuel Rawson, Jeremiah Richardson, Darius Lewis, Thomas Wight, Orin Miller, and William C. Dryer. Made under our hands and seals the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year 1834
