Be it remembered that at a meeting of the male members of the Universalist Society held at the house of Gordon Burlingame in the town of Virgil on the 7th day of May 1833 pursuant to public notice & according to statute incorporating and regulating religious societies in such case made and provided[,] Putman Dewolf and Nathan Heaton were duly nominated and elected to preside at said meeting and to certify and return the proceedings thereof to the Clerk of said county[;] That at said meeting it was unanimously resolved and agreed that said Society should forever hereafter be known and designated by the name & title of the Harford Universalist Society[;] That the following persons were then & there duly elected Trustees of said Society to wit: Josiah Hart[,] Heman Daniels and Nathan Heaton[,] and that said Trustees and their successors shall forever hereafter be known and called by the name & title of the Trustees of the Harford Universalist Society.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year first above written.
