Dayton the secretary of said meeting

After consultation had upon the subject it was unanimously Resolved

1st that said Society be known & distinguished by the name of the First Universalist Society in Webster

2^d that three Trustees be appointed to superintend the business of said Society to be classed one two & three whose terms of office expires number one in one year number two in two years & number three in three years

3^d that one clerk be chosen for said society to hold his office one year or until another be appointed

4th that Franklin Robb be the clerk of said society

5th that Reuben Cobb be first Nelson Peet be second & Willard Richards be third trustee

6th that one Treasurer be appointed for said society & that Ebenezer Cook be the Treasurer

7th that the time for holding annual meeting from and after this year be the second Saturday in October until otherwise directed by said society
