The Old Universalist Church

The old Universalist Church on Utica Street is the only one of the original churches of the village still standing. It was built by the Clinton branch of the Universalist society in the year 1821, at the cost of about \$2500. It is made of brick and has a gable roof but no steeple. The building is a compliment to the men who built it, for it still stands in good condition at its original location.

At the time it was built it was thought to be a very fine building, but it is small and insignificant compared with the churches of today.
