weeks and at least fifteen days previous
thereto due public notice was given
by the minister of such society in the
manner directed by the statute in such
case made and provided, on which day
and at the place aforesaid and at such
meeting the undersigned two of the mem-
bers of said society nominated for that
purpose by a majority of the male persons
of full age belonging to said society
there assembled presided ~~at~~ over the election
to receive the votes of the electors and to
be the judges of their qualifications and
of the persons elected and thereupon
by a plurality of voices of the persons
so assembled and qualified the
following named persons were duly
elected to serve as trustees for such
Society according to law, that is to say:

Hansen A. Olmsted, John Thwing, Alba
Paul, Henry Stenber and Gideon D. Cro-
foot.

And we the trustees aforesaid
so presiding at such meeting, hereby
further certify and return the names
of the trustee, so thereupon elected, and
that the name or title by which the
said trustee, and their successors, in
office as such shall forever hereafter
be called and known is and shall
be "The Trustee, of the First Universalist So-
ciety of Derby" and which is herein and
hence particularly mentioned and des-
cribed in pursuance of the Statute in
such case made and provided.
