DONALD O. FRAZIER [FRASER]

The Rev. Donald O. Frazier, age 70 years, who for several years served pastorates in New York State, died Saturday, January 17th in Rochester where he has resided for the past number of years.

Mr. Frazier was born in Scotland and came to this country when a young man. In 1873 he was graduated from the Theological School at St. Lawrence University. The same year he was married to Miss Mary Farmer, a native of St. Lawrence County, and accepted the pastorate of the Hailesboro Church. After a successful pastorate in this church he served several churches in the east. About twelve years ago he returned to New York State and for some time was minister of our church at Webster. For the past number of years he has been unable to preach.

Besides his widow he us survived by two children, Gertrude Frazier, a teacher in the Rochester schools, and Donald Frazier, an electrician in the same city.

Mr. Frazier was buried at Hailesboro.

Donald Frazier was a faithful minister. For some thirty years he preached 52 Sundays in each year. He was a kind and gentle man who worked untiringly during all the years of his vigor to proclaim by word and deed the gospel of fatherhood and brotherhood.
