Rev. Ralph Horne Dies in Dunkirk

Funeral services for the Rev. Ralph E. Horne, former Buffalonian, will be held Monday at the Congregational Church in Portland followed by burial in Forest Lawn Cemetery here.

The Rev. Mr. Horne, 70, died Thursday in Brooks Memorial Hospital, Dunkirk. Born in Stillwater, Me., he was a graduate of University of Maine and St. Lawrence University Divinity School. As a Universalist minister he held pastorates in New York, Pennsylvania and Canada. During his 30 years in Buffalo he was active in the affairs of Grace Universalist Church and the Church of the Messiah, occasionally filling their pulpits.

Although retired from the ministry for the last 20 years, the Rev. Mr. Horne had preached in churches in and near Fredonia. For the last 13 years he had lived in Lamberton, near Fredonia.

Surviving are his wife, Eva Webb Horne, for many years a teacher in Buffalo public schools; a daughter, Marion J. Horne of Columbia, B.C.; a son, Beecher, now with the armed forces, and a grandson.
