III. REV. SAMUEL JENKINS, M.D., died at Glen's Falls (Warren Co., N.Y.), December 20, 1873, in his fifty-ninth year. He was formerly and for several years an active and useful minister among us, having been ordained at Dover, N.H., June 23, 1843. To the regret of his brethren, but in obedience to what seemed to him the call of duty, he relinquished his post as a minister and entered the medical profession, in which he took a respectable rank. The Glens Falls *Messenger*, in announcing his death, spoke of him as a most estimable man in every relation of life. He was at one time an editor of the *Evangelical Magazine and Gospel Advocate*, published in Utica, which position he filled with credit to himself and the denomination. He was at other times connected with the press, and for over twenty years was a faithful and efficient laborer in the ministry.
