FORMER WESTDALE WOMAN SUCCUMBS TO PARALYSIS Mrs. Charles Barrows Passes Away at Home of Mrs. Flora Waldie in Dolgeville

After a seven weeks' illness resulting from a stroke of paralysis, Mrs. Mary L. Barrows of Westdale died Thursday afternoon, January seventh, at the home of Mrs. Flora Waldie at Dolgeville, N.Y. She was brought to the Waldie home at the time she became ill.

The deceased was born April 25, 1856, and most of her life had been spent in Herkimer county. She resided for many years in Salisbury Center and later in Dolgeville, then Westdale. Mrs. Barrows was a kind-hearted woman, liked by all. She was a member of the Universalist church of Dolgeville.

The funeral was held from the home of Mrs. Waldie at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon, January 9, the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton [Universalist] officiating, and interment was made at Salisbury Center.
