AARON P. BETTIS

Saturday evening Aaron P. Bettis died at his home, 90 Washington street, after a brief illness of inflammation of the bowels. Mr. Bettis was born in Rome August 15, 1837. At the age of 21 he went to Frankfort, where he became a teamster and this has been his occupation since. He has [sic] lived in Utica for about 20 years, working for Moses Barney, B. L. Swancott and at the Mansion House stables. At Frankfort in 1864 he married Delina E. French, who survives, with one son, Olney D. of this city. He leaves a brother, Robert of Oregon, and a sister, Mrs. Jane Daniels of Phoenix. Mr. Bettis was a member of the Universalist Church.
