Frank Bliven, whose home had been in Bridgewater since he came here with his parents from Rhode Island a lad of 13 years, died at the County Hospital Thursday morning in his 87th year. He married Miss Anna Hall, and their daughter, Miss Mary Bliven, survives. His first wife died in 1863, and a few years later he married Miss Caroline Shaw of Cooperstown, who died some years ago [1895]. He was one of a large family, of whom three sisters, Mrs. Thompson and Mrs. Blackwell of Tacoma and MRs. Elizabeth Chapin, and three brothers, Edward Bliven of Michigan, Charles Bliven of Nevada and John Bliven, residing here, survive. The funeral services will be held from the home of his daughter, Miss Mary Bliven, to-morrow afternoon. The Rev. DeWitt Lamphear [Universalist] will officiate.
