WILLIAM BROWN FUNERAL SET FOR SUNDAY

Services for William Henry Brown, 80, former designer and inventor, and uncle of Charles and Julian Brown of Syracuse, who died Thursday afternoon at the Brook's convalescent home, 1472 S. State st., will take place at the Briggs Brothers funeral home, Homer, Sunday at 2 p.m. Rev. Edward C. Downey, pastor of [the] Universalist Church, Cortland, will officiate and burial will be in Scott Union cemetery.

Brown was a mechanical designer for the old H. H. Franklin Manufacturing Company for many years and was inventor of a threshing machine. He was a brother of the late Alexander T. Brown, Syracuse gear manufacturer.

Surviving are a son, Alexander M. Brown of Syracuse; a daughter, Mrs. Alton J. Fenner of Herkimer; a grandson, Douglas Alexander Brown, and two nephews, Julian S. and Charles S. Brown.
