John J. Bulger

John J. Bulger, 74, a former resident of this village, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Anthony Beekman on West Main street, St. Johnsville, Sunday afternoon after being in ill health for two years.

Mr. Bulger was born in the Town of Minden February 15, 1864, the son of John and Betsy Pickard Bulger, and had been a resident of Fort Plain until the past seven years, when he and his wife moved to St. Johnsville to reside with Mrs. Beekman. Before his retirement he was employed at the old Bailey Knitting Mills and the Hix Furniture Company. He was a member of Mohawk Valley Lodge, K. of P., which he served as past chancellor.

Besides his widow and daughter, he is survived by one brother, R. [Robert] Simon Bulger of this village, three grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at the Beekman home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock and at 2:30 o'clock at the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel here. Rev. William A. Haney, pastor of the local Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
