*NINETY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE*

Death of George Cole, the Oldest Resident of the Town of Batavia

George Cole died at his home at No. State street yesterday morning at 3:15 o'clock from old age and the effects of a stroke of paralysis received many years ago. He was 95 years of age on September 28th. He had been feeling unusually well up to about two weeks ago, when his health began to fail. He leaves three daughters, Miss Martha Cole, who lived with him; Mrs. Emily Wilson of Ridge Road, Niagara county, and Mrs. Mary Hoag of Elgin, Ill., and one son, Daniel D. Cole of Tecumseh, Mich. Thirteen grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren also survive him, as well as two brothers, David Cole of Elmira and M. T. Cole of Oak Park, Ill. The funeral will be held from the home on Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, and at 11 o'clock the remains will be taken to Alexander where he at one time resided. The Rev. C. [Chester] C. Richardson [Universalist] of Warsaw will officiate.
