MRS. SARAH EADES
Funeral Was Held Yesterday Afternoon

Dolgeville, Nov. 28.—The funeral of the late Mrs. Sarah Eades was held from the Universalist Church in this village yesterday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The Rev. M. G. Folsom officiated and interment was made in the local cemetery. Mrs. Eades was 62 years old. Death was due to Bright's disease, from which she had been a sufferer for a long time. Mrs. Eades was the daughter of John Smith and Rebecca Cramer. She was born in the town of Oppenheim and had always lived in this vicinity, coming here a few years ago to reside in Dolgeville. She was married to William Eades, who died at about the time Mrs. Eades came to this village. The deceased was an exemplary christian and enjoyed the high esteem of a wide circle of friends. She is survived by one daughter, Miss Delcia Eades; by two brothers, Charles Smith of St. Johnsville and Eugene of Lotville; and by three sisters, Mrs. Nathan Mosher of this village, Mrs. Etta Walrath and Mrs. Nathan Cross of St. Johnsville.
