MRS. ALLEN ECKLER
Died at Her Home in Van Hornesville

Fort Plain, Feb. 11.—Mrs. Allen Eckler, a life-long citizen of Van Hornesville, died at her home in that village Saturday morning, after a two weeks' illness with pneumonia, in her 83d year. The deceased was a lady highly esteemed by a large circle of friends. She survived her husband, the late Allen Eckler, by nine months.
