Oscar S. Edgerly died very suddenly at his residence on Monday morning while sitting in his chair. He had been feeble since March, complaining much of a pain in his stomach. Sunday evening he rode out and he slept but little during the night. Cause of death was probably apoplexy [a stroke]. He was born in Perry in 1820 and was a son of Thomas and Sally Edgerly. In 1840 he was united in marriage to Miss Charlotte Kingsley, daughter of Josiah Kingsley. They had three children, all boys, only one of whom lives, Mr. Clark M. Edgerly. Mr. Edgerly was much esteemed by his friends and neighbors as a good man and citizen. The funeral took place on Wednesday, Rev. H. C. Munson [minister of the Universalist Church] officiating.
