Jennie Egan Passes After Long Illness

Mrs. Jennie Adam Egan passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Judson L. [Isabel] Rice at Sodus, on Friday, Feb. 28, 1947 after a long illness.

Mrs. Egan was born in East Bloomfield, where she spent her girlhood. She attended Brockport Normal school, and after graduation taught for four years in the rural school at Conesus. After her marriage to Mr. [John H.] Egan she lived in Newark until Mr. Egan's death in 1925, when she came to live with her daughter, Mrs. Clayton P. Bridges, in Macedon. Later she made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Rice, in Sodus. She was a member of the Macedon Universalist church.

She is survived by her daughters, Mrs. Judson L. Rice of Sodus, Mrs. Norval S. [Alice] Benjamin and Mrs. Clayton P. Bridges of Elba; also six grandchildren.

Her body rested in the Palmyra Funeral Home in Macedon until Sunday, when it was removed to the Universalist Church, from which services were conducted, the Rev. John O. Bennett, pastor, officiating. Burial was made in East Newark cemetery.
