PASSED AWAY AT AGE OF 92 YEARS

Mrs. Irene Coston Goff, wife of the late Lusian [Lucian] H. Goff, died at her home at South Hornell on the state road at 5:28 p.m., Thursday, April 14. She had been active and in good health, doing her house work, until 2 weeks previously when she was taken with an embolism in the arm. She grew worse and died at the age of 92 years, 8 months and 12 days.

Mrs. Goff was a native of Canisteo. She was born on the Coston homestead on Bennetts Creek. Her parents were the late John and Anna Miller Coston. Her early life was spent here. Following her marriage she lived on the farm where she died in the town of Hornellsville. She was held in high esteem by all who knew her.

She leaves 2 sons John H. and Robert C., who reside at home; 1 daughter, Mrs. Thomas Allen of Osinning; a grandson, Kenneth Preston Allen; and several neices and nepews [nieces and nephews], one of whom is Pitt E. Coston of Hornell.

The funeral was held from the Williams funeral chapel in Canisteo Monday at 2 p.m. Rev. J[oseph] A. Judd of 25 Genesee street, Hornell, pastor of the Woodbury Universalist church, officiated. Burial was made in Hope cemetery, Hornell.
