Clarence Hanor Dies in Hospital

Sidney—Clarence D. Hanor, 74, of Masonville died at the Fox Memorial Hospital, Oneonta, yesterday after a long illness. His wife, the former Hattie Travis, died while they were in Florida on Nov. 30 of last year.

He was born July 23, 1879, in North Hillsdale, the son of Charles and Sarah (Wilber) Hanor.
