WILLIAM HAVEN

Died Suddenly Last Friday Morning at the Home of His Son

William Haven passed from this life at the home of his son, Mett M. Haven, on the Wellsville road, Friday morning, Dec. 31st, 1915, aged 67 years.

Mr. Haven was one of eleven children of which three brothers survive.

He was married to Miss Jennie Barnhart, who died eight years ago. Three children came to bless this union: George Haven of Wellsville, Mett of this place, and Robert V. of Olean.

Mr. Haven had been feeble for some time and everything that could be done for him was done. He has lived with his son Mett for a number of years.

Although his precarious condition was known to the family, and they were very watchful, it came as a shock Friday morning to find him sleeping that sleep from which he shall not wake in this world.

He is survived by the three sons, three granddaughter[s], five grandsons and three brothers: Mett, Ezra and Frank of Swains.

The funeral was held from the Universalist Church at one o'clock Sunday afternoon, Rev. C. [Clark] L. Paddock officiating. Interment was in the family lot in Rural cemetery.

Among those from out of town present at the funeral were: Robert Haven of Olean, Mr. and Mrs. Geo. Haven of Wellsville; Ezra, Mett and Frank Haven of Swains.
