DIES SUDDENLY

Mrs. Cora M. Homrighaus died suddenly at 7 Thursday night at her home in the Dutchtown section of the Town of Salisbury. Since the death of her son, Sgt. Frank Homrighaus, who died of wounds in Italy May 18, 1944, she had been in failing health. However, her death was entirely unexpected.

Mrs. Homrighaus was born January 17, 1887 in the Town of Salisbury where she had spent all of her life. Her parents were Horace and Elizabeth Metz Doxtader.

Mrs. Homrighaus was a member of the Universalist church of Salisbury Center, of the Ladies Aid Society of the church, Salisbury Center Grange and Rising Crown Rebekah lodge of Dolgeville.

On July 18, 1905 she was married to George Homrighaus, who survives, with one son, Linford of Little Falls and one granddaughter, Beverly, one sister, Mrs. Elvamina Foster of Solsville, several cousins, nephews and nieces.

The funeral will be held at 2:30 Sunday afternoon from the home. Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church will officiate. Burial will be in the Tuttle cemetery in Salisbury Center.
