Mrs. I. L. Hotchkiss Dies; All Souls Church Member

Mrs. Ida Lyon Hotchkiss of 580 E. 19th st., one of the oldest members of All Souls Universalist Church and the daughter of its first pastor, the Rev. Henry Lyon, died yesterday at Westerly, R. I., where she was spending the summer. She was seized with a stroke of apoplexy ten days ago.

Mrs. Hotchkiss was the widow of G. Sherman Hotchkiss and was a lifelong resident of Brooklyn. Her mother was the late Mary McCoy. She was 72 years old and was a member of All Souls Church all of her life. She had long been active in the Central Circle of the Women's League of the church. She is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Howard R. Merrill; a son, Harold S. Hotchkiss, and a brother, Clarence Lyon, now of Pittsburg, who was long active at All Souls and is still honorary secretary of its board of trustees. Services will be held at her late home tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock, with the Rev. Dr. Thomas E. Potterton, pastor of the Universalist Church of Good Tidings, officiating. Interment will be in Cypress Hills Cemetery.
