Robert S. Howard

Bridgewater, May 23.—The death of Robert S. Howard occurred suddenly at his home here Sunday. He was born in Frankfort April 4, 1830, and was one of a family of eight children. [On] January 1, 1866 he married Miss Elizabeth Dolloff of Mohawk. He had followed a variety of occupations, carpentering, milling, farming, etc. In recent years he has resided on a small farm south of the village. He was a staunch Republican and a Universalist but he had never united with the church. He is survived by his wife and three children, Ella, who resides with her mother, and Hudson and Stephen, both of this place. He is also survived by two brothers, (Luteus?) Howard of Newton, Ia., and Freeman Howard of Mohawk, and one sister, Mrs. Mary Hubbell of Utica.
